An Overview

About The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) is the apex body in the field of accountancy and auditing. ICAI, a partner in nation building, is also involved in on-going accounting reforms and improvement of financial reporting and public financial management in various Government entities/ departments including Local Bodies in India.

About The Committee on Public & Government Financial Management

The ICAI through its Committee on Public and Government Financial Management (CPGFM) is involved in sensitising the concerned officials and society at large about benefits of accounting reforms by organising various workshops/ training programmes/ developing e-leaning modules and orgainising interactions and knowledge sharing exercises with the Government organs apart from formulating Accounting Standards for Local Bodies (ASLBs). The Committee also provides technical inputs on Government accounting related matters to Government Accounting Standards Advisory board (GASAB) in India and Internationally on the documents of International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB). The Committee is also contributing in development of study material of the Certificate Courses for Accountants of Panchayats and Municipal Bodies being run through Board for Local Bodies Accountants Certification [BLoAC that has been established under ICAI Accounting Research Foundation (ICAI ARF)].

Vision of CPGFM 2023-24

- To approach decision makers and stakeholders of Government Accounting and Public Financial Management to consider adopting and implementing standards in Government Accounting, especially for local bodies for accountability and transparency.
- The Committee focuses on capacity building of the finance officials of various tiers of Government in India and other extended entites like PSUs, autonomous bodies etc. by various means such as Workshops, relevant E-training modules, Webinars and Training Programmes.
- Creating awareness about the existing Government Accounting and Public Financial Management Mechanism amongst CAs.

Mission of CPGFM

To assist Central & State Governments and Local Bodies in successful implementation of the accounting reforms and public finance management.

Terms of Reference

- (i) To conceive of and suggest areas in which Accounting Standards for Local Bodies need to be developed and formulate them.
- (ii) To examine how far International Public Sector Accounting Standards(IPSASs) prepared by the International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB) of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) can be integrated into national Accounting Standards for Local Bodies envisaged in paragraph (i) above and to integrate the same to the extent possible with a view to facilitate global harmonisation.



(Set up by an Act of Parliament)

- (iii) To review, at regular intervals, the Accounting Standards for Local Bodies from the point of view of acceptance or changed conditions, and, if necessary, revise the same.
- (iv) To provide, from time to time, interpretations and guidance on Accounting Standards for Local Bodies.
- (v) To enable creation of supportive environment for implementation of Accounting Standards for Local Bodies and respond to issues arising therefrom.
- (vi) To formulate comments on the drafts of accounting standards for governmental bodies issued by various authorities including International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB) of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC).
- (vii) To provide support to Government(s) and regulators, e.g., the proposed Governmental Level Technical Committee to be constituted under the aegis of Ministry of Urban Development and C&AG, in their endeavours towards various other aspects of financial reporting including preparation of asset registers, performance measurement, budgeting, costing, internal control and audit.
- (viii) To review, analyse, assist, recommend and suggest measures to the Central, State & Local Government in the areas of policy assessment, planning and execution in public finance.
- (ix) To collaborate and coordinate with relevant authorities and various Ministries/Covernment Departments/Local Bodies for developing a mechanism of improving the Government Accounting System and enhancing the role of members of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India thereat.
- (x) To provide awareness of Public Finance, Government Accounting & Accounting Standards for Local Bodies to the society at large and specifically to the stakeholders including inter-alia to employees of the government, C&AG, members of the profession, media, NGOs and to citizens generally including appropriately addressing the training issues.
- (xi) Enhancing the accountability and transparency in public service delivery mechanism.
- (xii) To bring out newsletter, publications, and other useful inputs in areas of contemporary issues related to public finance and accounting standards for Local Bodies.
- (xiii) To suggest checks and balances for monitoring periodical review/ audit of end use of funds.
- (xiv) To increase the role of ICAI and its members in various "Financial Inclusion" initiatives of the Government which would mainly emphasis on:
 - Assisting government in bringing appropriate regulatory and educational policy framework in place.
 - Collaborating intensively with different chambers and associations of industry.
- (xv) To carry out such other work relating to Public Finance, Accounting Standards for Local Bodies and other related aspects as may be entrusted to it by the Council.

All India Conference on "GRAM: Strengthening of Accounting at Grass Roots" held on 1st September, 2023.

In pursuance of the MoU entered with the O/o CAG of India on 9th August, 2023, the Hon'ble CAG of India, Shri Girish Chandra Murmu in the presence of CA. Aniket S. Talati, Hon'ble President, ICAI, CA. Kemisha Soni, Chairperson, CPGFM and CA. Prasanna Kumar D, Vice-Chairperson, CPGFM launched the Certificate Course for Accountants of Panchayats and Municipal Bodies on Audit Diwas (i.e. 16th November, 2023) to create a pool of trained accounting personnel at grassroots level in India.

These courses are being run through Board for Local Bodies Accountants Certification (BLoAC) established under the aegis of the ICAI Accounting Research Foundation (ICAI ARF). CPGFM is contributing to development of study material and co-ordination with O/o CAG. The registrations of these skill development courses have been initiated from 1st December, 2023 through a dedicated website (https://lba.icaiarf.org.in/) at nominal registration fees of Rs. 590/- (inclusive of GST) for class XIIth passed students from any stream.

The mode of learning is online and accessible in 10 languages (Hindi, English, Marathi, Tamil, Odiya, Gujarati, Punjabi, Bengali, Kannada and Telugu). The exams will be conducted offline in regional languages using ICAI's robust examination system. The list of qualified candidates will be made available in public domain. It is targeted to make available the first batch of trained qualified accountants in next 5-6 months in the States that can be engaged in the preparation of accounts by panchayats and municipal bodies.
